



INSTALLATION (CONT.)

(Continued)

- Screw the four T-20 screws back into the sides of the third brake light. (Figure A)
- 2. Run the wire in the vehicle.
 - Connect the **BLACK** wire to chassis ground
 - Connect the RED wire to 12V accessory or reverse depending on the desired function of the camera.
- Connect the YELLOW RCA to the video input of the monitor. If using as a reverse camera, RCA may need to be connected to the backup camera RCA on the monitor.


